Meeting Called to Order at 4:05 p.m.

Approval of Minutes

- Correct minutes as to the wording of the horse arena to read "Gibson WAS asked why...". Jim Schuld was removed as an alternate because of health problems.
- *JoAnn Herrigel made motion to approve minutes with above stated correction. Tony Clark seconded the motion. Motion approved unanimously.*

Action Items

- **DAB:** The letter composed by T. Clark and signed by the Committee was in the DAB packets. It wasn't really discussed at January's meeting. There may be a need to ask for the issue to be an action item or to pass a resolution in the future. S. Shawn and T. Clark discussed forming a subcommittee to formulate a set of stronger recommendations. Dick will request the issue to be put on the agenda.
- **Dog Park hours:** A Neighbor or D. Shook's sees and hears people and their dogs before and after the park opens and closes. K. Cayson is currently advertising for an onsite caretaker which should fix the problem. T. Clark requested a temporary, weatherproof bulletin board at the entrance of the dog park.
- **Creeks update:** 600 live stakes were put in. There are 1500-2000 bare root plants that have been purchased and will be planted in the riparian zones of Camas and Mt. Scott Creeks. The Youth Corp. is coming again starting in February for 12 Saturdays and will be working in many of the NCPRD parks.
- **Noise Study:** S. Shook stated that a sound barrier wall adjacent to the fence or dugout along with the other solutions weren't fiscally feasible. Standlee did the sound study at Lakeridge High School as well as the NCP study, so the District will request information about the Lakeridge solutions. S. Berliner suggested the consultant visit and explain the report and the solutions suggested in the sound report. All Committee members strongly agreed (1 finger). Committee members

and neighbors are to get their questions in to T. Burns before the meeting. Some info requested already was: a demo of specific sound levels, Lakeridge sound solution, the estimated costs of the various solutions and examples of barrier effects.

- **Earth Day:** Committee will ask E. Shawn at the February meeting about Earth Day and combining events with Milwaukie events the Shawns are already involved in. Anything that is planned cannot conflict with stakeholder events in the April. A volunteer day on April 17 may be organized, and that would be all. Jon Isaac offered a service event to T. Burns involving the students at CHPCS.
- **North Side Planning:** The Title 13 process is moving along. The City of Milwaukie has asked that the District get the master plan adopted into their master plan prior to beginning the land use process. T. Burns is almost ready to submit the plans. S. Shawn requested that T. Burns have the Committee review the NCP plans before submittal. T. Burns showed a copy of the final concept plan to the group and assured everyone that the plan had not changed since the last time they reviewed the plans.

OMBUDS ACTIVITY: REQUESTS & REPORTS

- **Parking/parents' student drop-offs:** The new gate was installed by the Friends of NCP. The gate is locked during school hours and only opens for student pick-up and drop-off. There has been no parking at the Milwaukie Center and the traffic back-up on Rusk Road has gotten much better. It all is working great.
- **Draft letter on creeks and noise:** The letter has been reviewed by P. Girtman. T. Burns gave it back to A. O'Donnell so they can finalize it together.
